Subject: Request for inputs to the UN Secretary-General's report on the global compact for safe orderly and regular migration

The Office of the United Nations Special Representative of the Secretary-General (SRSG) for International Migration presents its compliments to all Permanent Representatives of Member and Observer States to the United and has the honour to refer to Resolution A/RES/71/280, entitled "Modalities for the intergovernmental negotiations of the global compact for safe, orderly and regular migration", adopted by the General Assembly on 6 April 2017.
